QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree, in human services / social work/ counseling field.
- Experience in counseling and crisis intervention preferred
- Knowledge of sexual assault preferred
- Ability to deal sensitively with victims of sexual assault/abuse and their significant others.

- Ability to work a flexible schedule
- Fluency in speaking, writing and providing therapy in the Spanish language.
- Must have or be willing to undergo 40 -hour sexual assault crisis worker training.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide counseling to victims of sexual violence from Latino cultures and their significant others.
- Facilitate support groups for adult and adolescent survivors as needed.
- Provide survivors with information about other sexual violence services if needed
- Perform outreach to other area services providers, local officials, schools, and other agencies, to inform them of Northwest CASA's services and to recommend mutual referrals where appropriate
- On rotation with other staff to take weekend shifts to provide back up to 24/7 crisis hotline which provides telephone crisis counseling and in-person response to hospital emergency rooms.
- Maintain comprehensive client records as required
- Maintain statistical records of counseling services performed for multiple funding sources
- Maintain client confidentiality as required by law, professional code of ethics, and funding sources
- Follow policies and procedures contained in the Northwest CASA Policy and Procedure Manual
- Provide education and training programs to social services agencies as requested.
- Perform other duties as assigned
